5. Presentation – Middle School Steering Committee Findings
 - A. A presentation was given by the Steering Committee. Those items the committee discussed as important in planning for a new Middle School were detailed: Classrooms, Media/Library, Technology, Cafeteria/Common Space, Flex/Breakout workspace, Interdisciplinary Space, Multi-purpose room, Performance area, and Security.
 - B. Three potential scenarios were presented. Each took into account solutions provided for current areas needing improvement, teacher input, location and yearly operating cost additions as well as cost/benefit comparisons.
 - C. Results of the community public opinion survey were shared. The survey results aligned with input with the engagement sessions held. The survey indicated a strong base of support on which to move forward.
 - D. The recommendation is for the Board to move forward with a Middle School addition to the High School as the preferred scenario.
