1. FY21 Audit
Done on time. It says adverse- any school that uses cash based says adverse. The Auditors praised how well it was going and how well organized it was this year. This was uploaded into the ISBE site.
2. Strategic Plan
Started a couple weeks ago w/ Joe Porto- 2018 strategic plan prioritize where we are w/ goals and
where we are going next. 1:1 initiative. Curriculum updates in person meeting. 13 parents and 4 students with admin team and teachers from all buildings.
3. Building Update
Concrete pump truck- too wet so it was delayed. In 2 weeks the precast walls will go up. The elevator
tower has already been installed.
4. 2022-2023/2023-2024 Calendars
How construction will impact calendar- Summer 2023 will be longer to complete the HS construction.
We will need to move HS graduation up for 2022/2023.

5. Tentative Levy

Potential 125K on appeals.

Need to do truth to taxation hearing that will be held before December meeting.
6. School Report Card
Issued end of October every year. MS only school that tested in 2020 before shut down. Missing 2 years of comparison data. IAR 3 <sup>rd</sup> -8 <sup>th</sup> grade. SAT Junior year. We are low performing due to SPED pop.
District attendance 2021 remote tracking 95%. State average 92.5%.
7. Forsyth Baseball/Softball Diamonds
Long term lease possible for 20 years. Forsyth will put turf in fields. 15k first 10 years and 20k last 10 years. All 4 teams would play in Forsyth and they would take tare of all maintenance. This is very preliminary. Just began talking at Park district, but wanted to gauge interest.
8. GS Camera System Replacement
ECF Money came in- ESSER III- 107k total bid. Action item is to order now as there is a long lead time.
Summer they will begin install- worst case will be Winter break 2022.  50k coming from ESSER III to cover cameras.
9. Parking/Registration/Fee Collection
Last year there were 106 sold. This year there are 124. When the student purchases their pass, it registers their car so we can reference in case of emergency.
10. COVID-19 Update
19 kids doing test to stay. There is currently a big lawsuit with 145 districts. The State of Education is beginning to support schools going to choice.
11. Bond Abatement and Transfer
Covered with Levy.
12. Streaming Board Meetings
