Through the generous donations of community members, alumni, and local businesses, the Foundation has provided more than \$175,000 in educational funding. The Foundation also manages multiple family endowments that award college scholarships to MF graduating seniors.



Where Your Dollars Go

Through the generous donations of our community, here are a few of the classroom grants the MF Foundation has awarded:

- \$2,900 for 2nd grade document cameras
- \$4,500 to assist District with purchase of new band uniforms
- \$2,500 for High School dance team mirrors
- \$2,500 for High School greenhouse equipment
- \$6,500 for science lab activities
- \$1,500 for Grade School health fair
- \$4,500 for High School chorus department formal wear
- \$8,500 for band instruments
- \$8,500 for Grade School and Middle School books for libraries and classrooms
- \$6,400 for a kiln for the High School art department
- \$9,000 over 3 years for new library books
- \$10,000 for Middle School Chrome books
- \$1,500 for poster maker for High School
- \$10,000 for Middle School virtual reality goggles and software
